### The Church of St. John and St. Mary

#### Past & Present

+ The Little Church was built with the generosity of one woman, Catherine Manning McKeon, in memory of her parents John & Mary Manning in 1922.By 1924, there were 40 families in the parish.

- + Ten years later, in 1933, Catherine McKeon again generously donated the land and house that became our parish rectory. + In 1958, Sts. John & Mary Parish School was opened for grades 1-8 on Poillon Road. It remained open until 1972.
- + In 1997 the interior of the school was redesigned to include the Upper Church, Skelly Hall, Kitchen, Family Room, Parish Office, Religious Ed. & Youth Ministries. + There were **925** families in the parish with **400** students in the Rel. Ed. program.
- + **Today** we serve a diverse family of faith with **1150** households. With over **15** ministries, we joyfully live our faith and serve the Lord, living the Gospel.
- + **590** young people are taught about their faith through our exceptional religious education program and another **170** students continue their faith journey through youth group, retreats and service. + We are a growing parish where this past
- + We are a growing parish where this past year **18** babies were baptized, **15** couples celebrated the sacrament of marriage, and **57** young adults received confirmation.
